



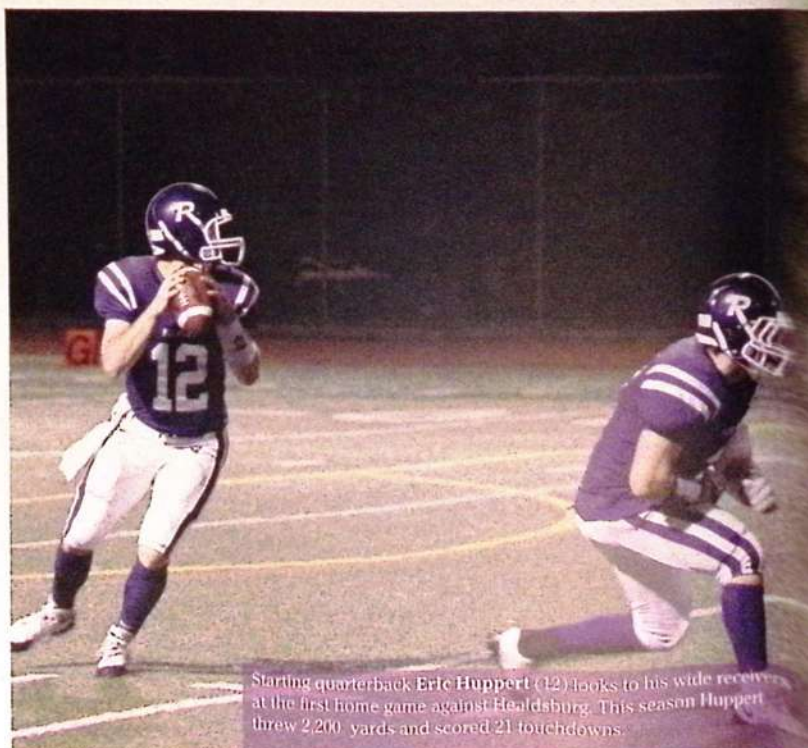

Our Colors Shine

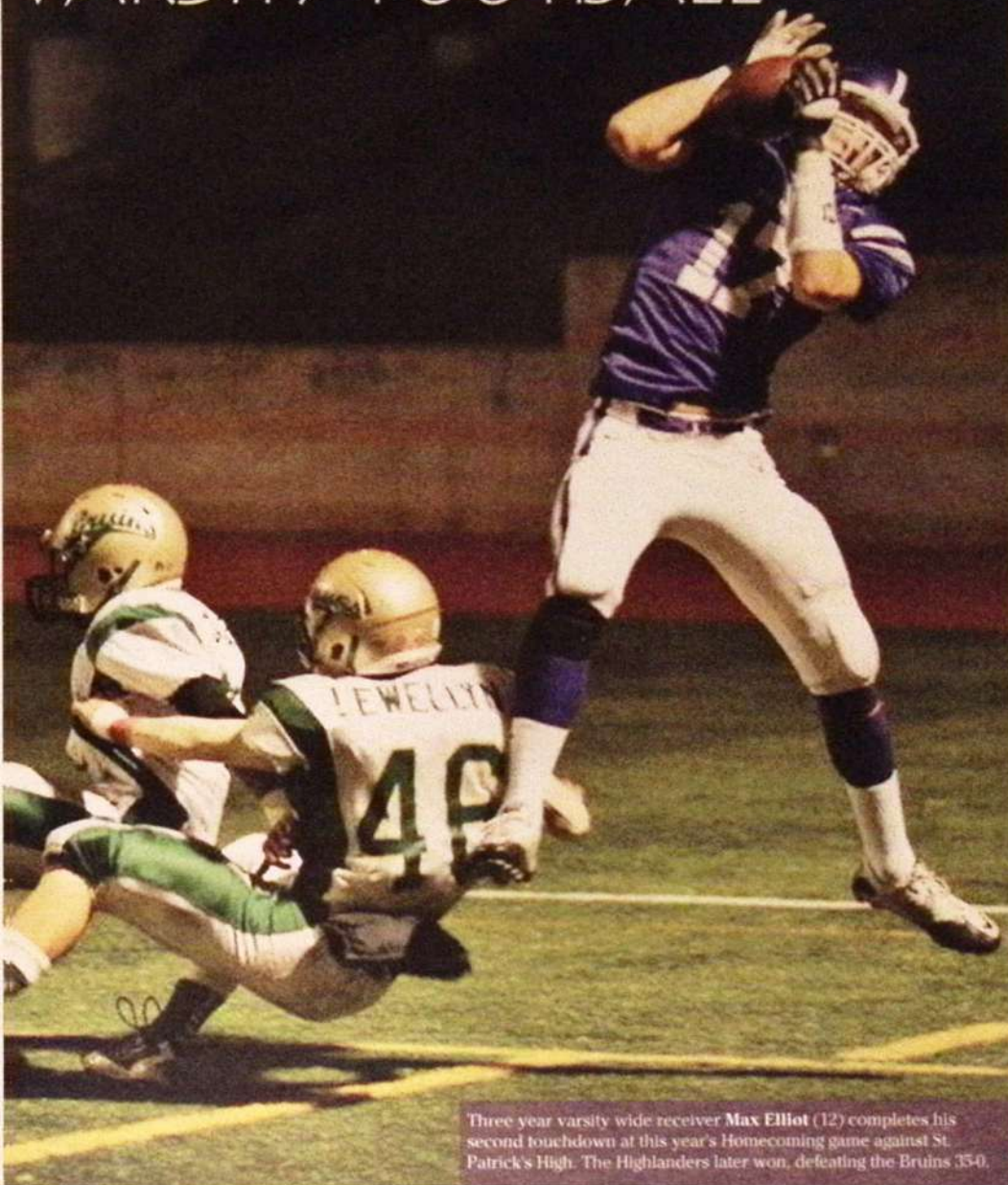

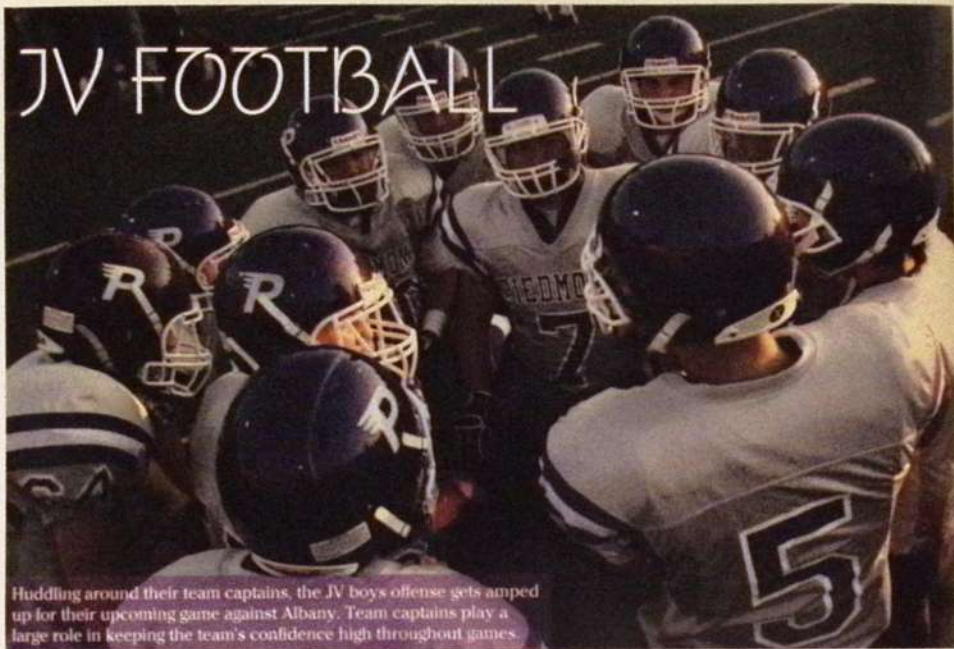

JV FOOTBALL
